Correspondence	In summary majority of correspondence was from Michael Hanratty and Matthew Starr from the Sports Club. Some advice received from Good Sports.
President's report	<p><i>Since we last met, we have been stopped by rain at a number of our games and this is becoming a regular occurrence, however it has allowed for financial savings!!.</i></p> <p><i>The club has required meetings with the agenda reflecting the discussions. Neville and I have had with them also the question of Governance, how we do things, and the processes needed to maintain compliance, so there is need for regulation.</i></p> <p><i>While the subject of clothing and storage is not resolved so need to find a suitable area to store and retrieve at our convenience. The storage offered at Bankstown Sports was limited to Mon to Fri and 9 to 5.</i></p> <p><i>This will be the last meeting at my home as I have decided not to stand for any positions.</i></p>
Treasurer's report	<p>Robert Goodall is currently acting in the treasurer's role and is doing a good job at that.</p> <p>Bank statement = \$6124.69+ Cash = \$6285 Balance = \$12406.69</p> <p>It was noted that the recent wet weather cancelations have meant we have had little expenditure. Also noted that \$2600 of this amount is committed to the purchase of a Defibrillator and \$3000 is committed to the purchase of club jumpers/sweatshirts.</p> <p>Following the resignation of Jim Gardner action is required to update banking details. Consider changing banks to one that offers EFPOS facilities and tap and go technology. Incoming treasurer to investigate.</p>

2-ball ambrose championship by-law	<p>At the last AGM the question was raised regarding the implementation of the current by-law requiring 2-ball players to come from Division 1 and Division 2. This by-law has been largely ignored over the last couple of years. The question is, do we implement this by-law or continue to ignore it? (Round 1 is scheduled for 22 June at the Ridge.)</p> <p><b>The Committee agreed that this by-law should be implemented. Actual division to be determined by the number of available players with half the field allocated to division 1 and half allocated to division 2. Note that cart requirements maybe an issue.</b></p>
Upcoming AGM	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Notice of motion to change the Constitution <i>That the position of Members' representative be renamed to that of Club Vice-Captain. The role of the Member's representative would be maintained but additionally the Vice Captain would have the additional responsibility to support/deputise for the Club Captain.</i></li> <li>2. Nomination forms for the executive positions in the Club need to be available at the next two lead-up games.</li> <li>3. Issue of whether subscription is to be applied and if so how much is appropriate.</li> <li>4. Committee to raise any further issues that need to be presented to the members at the AGM.
